Be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage with great patience and careful instruction. Be a soul winner for the Lord. Let our words and our actions go together. So, what is the purpose of the Word? It is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness; so that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. But you have to believe the Bible is the very word of God and you have to

have faith in God and faith that Jesus is the Son of God in order for the Word to have any effect on your life.

John 20:30-31 *30 And truly Jesus* did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ. the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name.
